

Banff Community Bird Walks

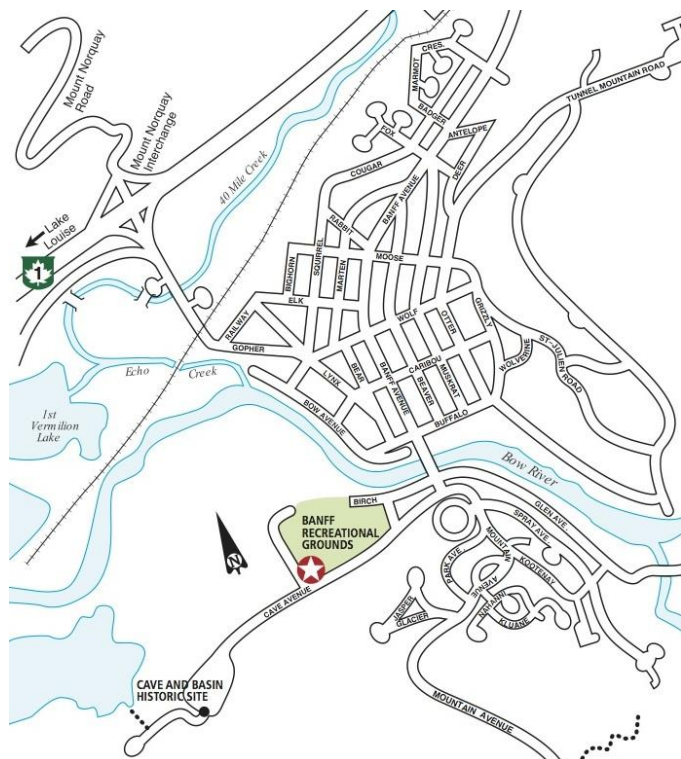
Sharing in the Spring Migration
